Happy Holidays on behalf of everyone at Gateways to Change and Artists' Exchange!

We are very thankful to all those who support our efforts! Our Year in Review includes:

- The Champlin Foundation has approved a grant in the sum of \$39,750 to help us repave our parking lot at 1060Park Ave! The project will begin in the spring of next year and include re-grading, re-surfacing, re-striping, and re-installation of parking bumpers.
- The carpet at our main building was replaced with durable laminate flooring which is easier for our folks to navigate.
- The William H. Donner Foundation awards a \$30,000 grant to support our creation of a sensory room, community-based yoga classes, and purchase of emergency clothing and supplies for the folks in our residential programs.
- Bob's Discount Furniture has donated gift cards totaling \$6,000 annually!!! This major contribution reduces our dependency on state issued furniture and gives our houses the "homey" feel!
- Habitat for Humanity West Bay & Northern RI partnered with Team WPRI volunteers to paint the interior of our Amy Drive residence as part of Nexstar's Founder's Day of Caring.
- The Rhode Island Lottery treats us to a Pawtucket Red Sox game with free BBQ lunch & a First Pitch opportunity!
- The RI State Elks Association invited us to the annual cookout at the beautiful Masonic Park in Warwick!



- Representative Nicholas Mattiello & the John E. Fogarty Foundation provided grants in support of our weekly yoga program and our monthly soup kitchen held at Characters Café!
- The Rhode Island Foundation provided a Basic Human Needs grant so that our folks can be comfortable with seasonal clothing, hats, gloves, and items that are often not funded.
- Thank you to everyone who helped our 16th annual golf tournament raise \$10k to be used for enriching community experiences for the folks at Gateways to Change! Tournament organizers Mr. & Mrs. Roland Moussally did an incredible job of welcoming everyone to Lincoln Country Club!
- The City of Cranston resurfaced the driveway at one of our group homes.
- Artists' Exchange is one of twenty organizations invited to make a grant request to the White Family Foundation.
- The Moran-Ventre Memorial Foundation sponsors A Christmas Carol at \$1,000!
- Shannon Casey assumes the Director position at Artists' Exchange!
